APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The applicant must be graduating from high school or equivalent schooling with a grade point average of a “B” or better in the state of Arizona. SAT and/or ACT scores are optional.
2. Four scholarships shall be limited to students who have been members or whose parent/parents have been members of one of the following organizations for three (3) consecutive years immediately prior to the application deadline:
 - a. JACL, Arizona Chapter
 - b. Arizona Buddhist Temple, 4142 W. Clarendon Ave, Phoenix, AZ 85019
 - c. Phoenix Light and Life Church, 15220 N. 39th Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85053
 - d. The youth group of the Arizona Buddhist Temple
 - e. The youth group of the Phoenix Light and Life Church
3. Separate scholarships known as the Herbert Jensen Scholarship, the Nakagawa Scholarship and the Kishiyama Scholarship shall be open to students of any ethnic background whose parent/parents have been members of the JACL, Arizona Chapter for three (3) consecutive years prior to the application deadline.
4. A scholarship known as the Joe Allman Scholarship shall be open to students who have been members or whose parent/parents have been members, of any of the above groups for three (3) consecutive years prior to the application deadline. Special consideration shall be given to any student currently in Scouting.
5. The requirement for volunteer hours to the Chapter has been waived again for 2022 seniors due to the pandemic.
